CONDITIONS

1. Prior to the commencement of the event, all participants, cyclists and drivers of event support vehicles shall be made aware of the terms and conditions of this permit (and associated Road Closure Permit if applicable);
2. The authorised route shall be followed and no deviations made by participants without prior consultation with local police;
3. Participants, cyclists and support personnel who will alight from the support vehicle shall, during hours of darkness, shortly after dawn and shortly before dusk, wear fluorescent safety vests, and body/head lighting;
4. The applicant shall ensure that children participating in the event are fully supervised and closely monitored at all times by responsible adults, closely by an adult cyclist and assistance by the support vehicles;
5. Participants, cyclists and drivers of event support vehicle/s shall obey all laws and regulations for the State of Queensland regarding the requirements for driving a vehicle on a roadway or road related area, this includes but is not limited to parks, lanes, pathways, tracks or driveways;
6. This permit does not exempt participants and drivers of event support vehicles from compliance with the provisions of the Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Road Rules) Regulation 1999 nor any other legislation (unless expressly stated in this permit);
7. The issue of this permit does not exempt the applicant from obtaining any relevant permit or authority required by another authority, occupier or owner, e.g. Local Government, Main Roads Department, private property owner, lease holder, etc.;
8. Participants, cyclists and drivers of event support vehicles shall take all necessary precautions to avoid any road incidents and shall immediately obey any lawful direction given by a police officer;
9. Participants shall utilise footpaths and paths where available (paying attention to Regulation 14 – Rules for Pedestrians, Transport Operations (Road Management – Road Rules) 1999;
10. Participants shall not unreasonably obstruct the path of another pedestrian and shall comply with all pedestrian and traffic lights;
11. Participants shall run not more than two abreast at any time;
12. Participant changeovers will not be conducted in heavy traffic areas;
13. All stoppages along the route shall be conducted in places that are located off the roadway e.g. parks, rest areas, etc.;
14. Should more than four (4) vehicles be delayed behind the event, event support vehicles shall move to the left of the roadway, pausing if necessary, or continuing forward, until the traffic build-up has cleared;
15. The event shall be temporarily suspended by the applicant, participant/s or police if undue traffic delays are experienced along the route. The suspension shall be for as long as it takes to clear the traffic build-up;
16. In heavy traffic, all event support vehicle/s shall travel independently of the participants;

17. Where participants are unable to proceed due to adverse or unsafe conditions, or official signs prohibit pedestrians, event support vehicles shall convey participants to a location along the route where it is safe and lawful for them to continue running;
18. Event support vehicles not designated as safety vehicles shall travel independently of the participants and shall not impede, obstruct or otherwise interfere with the effective flow of traffic;
19. The applicant shall ensure that the event is either suspended or cancelled if for any reason there is a danger to participants, other road users or the general public e.g. heavy rain, fog, serious accident, etc.;
20. This permit may be cancelled or the conditions altered by a police officer for the safe and effective regulation of traffic, or the safety of the general public and participants;
21. The applicant shall ensure that any animals involved in the event are under the control of a suitably qualified handler at all times;
22. The organiser shall ensure that basic first aid supplies are available to the event participants;
23. No fund-raising shall be conducted from the roadway;
24. Suitable public liability insurance should be arranged to cover this event;
25. The applicant shall ensure that a contact list is provided to the Police Planning Officer to ensure adequate two-way communications between Police and event staff;
26. A copy of this permit (and any associated permits) shall be held by the applicant during the event and shall be produced to police if required.

In respect of the permit application you gave, regarding a proposed special event, you are advised that I, Barry DAY, in my capacity as a Superintendent of Traffic within the meaning of the Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995, do not oppose the holding of the special event in accordance with the particulars provided in this notice
